

Requirements for Consigning Cattle To The Longhorn Round-Up Sale October 30, 2010 in West, Texas

- Consignments will be accepted until **October 18, 2010** by emailing or mailing the following:
 - a) Completed consignment form, one for each consignment. Form can be filled out and emailed to russellh@longhornroundup.com or printed and mailed to Russell Hooks, P.O. Box 37, Jonesboro, TX 76538.
 - b) Digital photo of each consignment at a 200 resolution submitted by email to russellh@longhornroundup.com
 - c) A Non-Refundable Promotional Fee of \$50.00 must be submitted when you request that I hold lots. Lots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

- Completed paperwork to be turned in upon arrival at sale facility will consist of the following:
 - a) One signed waiver per consignor.
 - b) Original certificate of registration (ITLA, TLBAA or both).
 - c) Properly completed and signed transfer application(s).
 - d) General Health Certificate. See Health Requirements page for details.

Cattle arrive from 9:00 am until 9:00 pm on Friday, October 29, 2010. (For early arrival on Thursday, October 28, 2010 please call 409-381-0616 to make arrangements).

Consignment Fee Schedule

- ❖ Non-refundable Promotional Fee of \$50.00 per consignment.
- ❖ Consignments selling for \$500 or less will only be charged the \$50 Promotional Fee.
- ❖ Consignments selling for over \$500 will be charged an additional 10% commission with a maximum commission charge of \$300.
- ❖ If you do not sell your consignment there is **no PO fee**. The \$50 Promotional Fee is non-refundable if the consignment is passed out (PO) or scratched from the sale. No substitutions will be accepted for scratched animals.
